## COORABAKH NP TRIP INFO

This trip is a Friday Morning start.

- If you intend to meet up either Friday night or Saturday morning please contact me at latest the Wednesday prior to the trip so that I can give you the location of and the access route to the base camp. It's well sign posted and easy enough to find, even in the dark. But if you ring me at home and cop the answering machine don't leave a message for me because the females in the household don't pass them on.
- Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> November is Federal Election. You will need to make either postal or absentee voting arrangements.

The trip provides :-

- good access for camper trailers over National Park and State Forest roads .
- plenty of scenic sites to visit.
- a short rainforest walk.
- a walk around an old tramway from the timber cutting days.
- Some day trip routes will be light to moderate 4WD'ing.

The base camp is located adjacent to a flowing stream, and has toilets and plenty of play area for kids.

The trip itinerary will go something like this ;-

- *Friday* :- meet at Coopernook, travelling over forest roads suitable for camping trailers, visiting scenic sites, establish base camp mid/late afternoon.
- *Saturday* :- Light to Moderate 4wd'ing over forest roads visiting sites of interest, return to camp mid/late afternoon, in time for a dip if you want.
- *Sunday* :- head across to the coast, some moderate 4Wd'ing and visit a couple of coastal lookouts. Route home will be via the coast roads to Coopernook

These plans are subject to change depending on weather & road conditions and logging operations.

I mentioned in last month's newsletter that Warren and Cheryl have offered their abode at Krambach as a stopover if you want to head up Thursday evening because of the distance. If you wish to avail yourself of the offer please phone Warren and let him know.
